- 3. (A) Use article 'the' before fall. The rise and the fall will be appropriate in the sentence.
- (C) Remove 'out'. 'Acquitted' takes 4. preposition 'of'.
- 5. (A) Replace 'do' with 'did'. Sentence is in Past Tense.
- 6. (C) Replace are with 'is'. We use verb according to the subject before the first preposition.
- 7. (A) Replace never I have seen with "never have I seen". Negative introductory sentence take inversion form.

- (B) Replace 'case' with 'cases'. According to 'case' should also be in Plural.
- 9. (C) Replace 'from' from 'since'. It shows point of past time in the sentence.
- 10. (B) Remove 'about'. We do not use about with discuss.
- 11. (B) Replace 'for' with 'of'. 'Accused of' will be the correct use in the sentence.
- 12. (D) No error.
- 13. (C) Replace 'have' with 'had'. Since sentence is in Past Tense.
- 14. (C) Add 'the' before least. 'Least' is the superlative degree of 'little'. Little - Less - Least and we use article 'the' before superlative degree.
