Affected - to influence - असर करना
Effect - Result - परिणाम | 12. (C) Change 'isn't it' into 'weren't they'. The sentence and the questions tag must be in the same tense. |
| 3. (C) Change 'that' into 'because'. | 13. (A) Change 'In' into 'for' |
| 4. (A) Change 'Instead of' into 'In spite of'. | 14. (C) Change 'their' into 'its'. Here adjective must be used according to the main subject and 'the ruling party' is the main subject here. |
