4. (C) Replace 'Prior of' with 'Prior to'. Prior takes preposition 'to' which means 'existing earlier in time'.

6. (B) Replace 'are' with 'is'. 'The number of' takes plural noun and singular verb.
7. (C) Change 'all' into 'every'.
8. (A) Replace 'a' with 'the'. Here in the sentence we are talking about a particular 'shirt'. Hence it should take article 'the'.
