## Explanation

1. (C) The sentence shall be in Active Voice of Past Indefinite Tense.
2. (C) The sentence is in Past Tense and shall be in Passive form.
3. (A) 'get off' or 'get down' means to alight from a vehicle.
4. (A) In these kinds of sentences, progressive form of 'stand' comes for living things that can move. For immovable object simple present or simple past comes.
5. (B) 'Everyone' is singular, hence will take 'is' and the sentence shall be in passive form.
6. (B) The sentence is affirmative, hence helping verb should come after subject.
7. (B) 'When' shows that the action was in progress in the past at that particular time, hence it should be in Past Continuous Tense.
8. (C) 'Not only..... but also' takes similar phrase or words.
9. (C) 'look forward to' takes ' $\mathrm{V}+$ ing' after it. $^{\text {it }}$
10. (B) In these kinds of sentences, progressive form of 'stand' comes for living things that can move. Simple present or simple past ( $\mathrm{V}_{1}$ or $\mathrm{V}_{2}$ ) comes for immovable objects.
11. (A) ' $\mathrm{V}_{3}$ ' of 'build' is 'built'.
12. (B) 'Accidents' is plural, hence it will take plural verb.
13. (B) 'Luggage' is plural.
14. (A) Here we need to emphasise the reason. 'Only' will come near 'because'.
15. (C) Change 'easy into easier'. A conjunction joins two adjectives of the same degree.
16. (C) Change 'stand upon' into 'stand out of', which means 'something different enough to be noticeable'.
17. (B) Change 'similarly' into 'similar'. To compare two nouns with each other, we need an adjectives.
18. (C) Change 'constitute' into 'constitutes', as the subject of the sentence 'the activity' is singular.


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25. (A) To describe an action completed before a certain moment in the past, Past Perfect Tense is used. Change 'wrote' into 'had written'.
26. (A) To express an action that begun before a certain point in the past and continued upto that time, Past Perfect Continuous Tense is used. Hence change 'had played' into 'had been playing'.
27. (B) 'Someone' will take 'one's' as a possessive pronoun.
28. (B) As part (B) is in passive, change 'embed' into 'embedded'.
29. (B) Change 'different' into 'differently' as it qualifies verb 'speak'.
30. (A) Change 'to drink' into 'drinking'. 'To take to drinking' means 'to become addicted to alcoholic drinks.
31. (A) ' $V_{3}$ ' of 'Broadcast' is the same.
32. (B) Change 'provide' into 'provides', as the subject 'the availability' is singular.
33. (A) Change 'much' into 'many', as cattle is plural countable noun.
34. (A) Remove 'the' before 'Man'. 'Man' without any article means 'human being'.
35. (A) Put 'he was' before 'walking' to have an appropriate sense of the sentence.
36. (C) Change 'needs' into 'need' as the verb is 'is' here.
37. (C) Change 'to have remembered' into 'to remember'.
38. (C) As the sentence is in Past tense, change 'have been' into 'had been'.
39. (B) As the period of time (last three days) is given and it seems the action (raining) is still going on, it comes under Present Perfect Continuous Tense. Thus, change 'It is raining' into 'It has been raining'.
40. (A) 'Computer' will take possessive adjective 'its'. Change 'their' into 'its'.
41. (C) 'Go with the wind' means 'to finish or gone as if with the wind'.
